## INVESTIGATION INTO ALLEGATIONS OF MALADMINISTRATION, CORRUPTION AND ABUSE OF OFFICE IN UGANDA HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

Reference is made to the above captioned matter.

The Inspectorate of Government has received a number of complaints containing allegations of financial misconduct, abuse of office and maladministration in the management of the affairs of Uganda Human Rights Commission (UHRC).

Section 12(a) of the Inspectorate of Government Act provides that;

*"For the purposes of performing its functions under the Act, the Inspectorate shall have the following powers- to authorize in writing any officer under its charges to conduct an inquiry or investigation of corruption, abuse of office and neglect of duty, and any other aspect that the Inspectorate is empowered to investigate into."*

The purpose of this letter therefore, is to inform you, that this office has commenced investigations into the matter; and, further to introduce to you Mr.

**Kharim Ainomugisha and Mr. Zakaria Tiberindwa**, our officers mandated to conduct the investigations.

You are asked to accord them the necessary assistance, including providing them with all the relevant documents and any additional information that maybe required during this investigation and, to make yourself and/or any officer under your charge available for an interview on any matter arising.
